A BILL FOR AN ACT ENTITLED: WAN ACT AMENDING SECTION 16-4-501. mCa, tG reduce the anaual fee for an all-beverage LICENSE ISSUED TO A UNIT OF A NATIONALLY CHARTERED VETERANS* ORGANIZATION."
be it enacted by the legislature of the state of montana
Section 1. Section $16-4-501, \mathrm{MCA}$, is amended to read:
w16-4-501. License and permit fees. (1) Each beer licensee licensed to sell either beer or table wine only, or both beer and table wine, under the provisions of this code, shall pay an annual license fee as follows:
(a) each brewer, wherever located, whose product is sold or offered for sale within the state, 5500 ; for each storage depoty $\$ 400 ;$
(b) each beer wholesalery 5400 ; each table wine distributor: \$400;
(c) each beer retailer, $\$ 200$; with a wine license arnenament, an additional \$200;
(d) for a license to sell beer at retail for off-premises consumption only, the same as a retail beer icense; for a license to sell table wine at retail for
off-premises consumption only, either alone or in conjunction with beer, \$200;
(e) any unit of a nationally chartered veterans" organization, \$50.
(2) The permit fee under 16-4-301(1) is computed at the rate of $\$ 15$ a day for each day beer is sold at those events lasting 2 or more days but in no case be less than $\$ 30$.
(3) The permit fee under $16-4-301(2)$ is $\$ 10$ for the sale of beer only or $\$ 20$ for the sale of all alcoholic beverages.
(4) Passenger carrier licenses shall be issued upon payment by the applicant of an annual license fee in the sum of $\$ 300$.
(5) The annual license fee for a license to sell wine on the premises, when issued as an amendment to a beer-only ifense, is \$200.
(6) The annual fee for resort retait liquor licenses within a given resort area shall be $\$ 2,000$ for each license.
(7) Each iicensee licensed under the quotas of 16-4-201 shall pay an annual license fee as follows:

In compliance with a written request received January _26_, 19 , there is hereby submitted a Fiscal Note for House B111 411 $\qquad$ pursuant to Title 5, Chapter 4, Part 2 of the Montana Code Annotated (MCA). Background information used in developing this Fiscal Note is available from the Office of Budget and Program Planning, to members of the Legislature upon request.

## Description of Proposed Legislation

An act to reduce the annual fee for an all-beverage 1 license issued to a unit of a nationally chartered veterans' organization.

## Assumptions

1. There are 56 all-beverage licenses that are issued to nationally chartered veteran organizations in the state.
2. No additional licenses will be issued in the coming biennium to these organizations.
3. The net effect of this proposal is to reduce the license fee by $\$ 150$, regardless of location.

## Fiscal Impact

This proposal would reduce license fee revenue by $\$ 8,400$ in each fiscal year.

## Local Impact

Local government revenues would be reduced by $\$ 4,200$ statewide because counties and cities may charge beverage license fees at one-half the state rate.

In compliance with a written request received February $2,19 \ldots 8$, there is hereby submitted a Fiscal Note for House Bill 411 (REVISED) pursuant to Chapter 53, Laws of Montana, 1965-Thirty-Ninth Legislative Assembly. Background information used in developing this Fiscal Note is available from the Office of Budget and Program Planning, to members of the Legislature upon request.

DESCRIPTION
This proposal would reduce the all-beverage license issued to a unit of a nationally chartered veteran's organization.

FISCAL IMPACT
There would be no fiscal impact resulting from this proposal. Prior to the 1975 recodification of state liquor statutes, the proposed fee was in the law. The recodification apparently inadvertantly moved the veteran's organization license into the same category as the all-beverages license. Since no change was debated or even seemed to be contemplated by the 1975 Session, the Department, unaware a change had occurred, continued to administer the fee at its pre-1975 level. Thus, the proposal would restore the legal basis for the way the fee is being administered
