for <u>HB 440</u> pursuant to Title 5, Chapter 4, F	Part 2 of the Montana Code Annotated (MCA).

Background information used in developing this Fiscal Note is available from the Office of Budget and Program Planning, to members of the Legislature upon request.

DESCRIPTION:

House Bill 440 is an act to provide a graduated system of fines for violation of the conservation speed limit; amending section 61-8-718, MCA.

ASSUMPTIONS:

There would be no expenditure impact by the passage of this bill. Revenue may increase, but cannot be calculated. Presently 75 to 80 thousand citations are issued annually for violation of the conservation speed limit. Upon enactment of this bill, the Department of Justice would expect an undetermined drop in the violations.

FISCAL IMPACT:

Revenue may increase but amount cannot be calculated. The revenue from these fines is now distributed as follows:

- 74% to Justice Court for costs
- 20% to Traffic Education Fund
 - 6% to Crime Victims Compensation Account
