SE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA: 10 11 Section 1. Purpose. The purpose of [this act] is to 12 make instructions evailable to the public, in easily 13 understood language, on how to probate a will or administer 14 an estate and to make available the forms necessary for 15 those purposes. Not all probates or administrations require 15 excensive legal expertise and [this act] is intended to 17 provide for assistance to personal representatives of those 13 estates not involving significant legal aspects and which are capable of being settled with a minimal amount of 19 20 expertise.

21 Section 2. Attorney general to prepare instructions 22 and forms. The attorney general shall prepare general 23 instructions, in easily understood language, on how to 24 prubate a will and administer an estate. The attorney 25 general shall also prepare forms for the documents that are generally necessary in the administration of an estate. The
attorney general shall review and revise the instructions
and forms to insure they are consistent with changing
statutory provisions.

5 Section 3. Distribution of probate instructions and 6 forms. The attorney general shall distribute the probate and 7 administration instructions and forms to the clerk of the 8 district court in each county. The clerk of the district 9 court shall then make the instructions and forms available 10 to the public at no charge.

Section 4. Cost to prepare, publish, and distribute instructions and forms. The cost incurred by the attorney general to prepare, publish, and distribute the instructions and forms provided for in [section 2] shall be reimbursedfrom the proceeds of the Montana estate and inheritance tax.

#### DESCRIPTION:

House bill 443 is an act to require the Attorney General to prepare instructions on how to probate a will or settle an estate and prepare necessary forms to distribute to the public.

#### ASSUMPTIONS:

- 1. Preparation of forms will require the expertise of a probate attorney. It will be necessary to contract with private counsel to develop instructions and forms.
- 2. Approximately 20,000 sets of instructions and forms will be required annually.
- 3. A training session will be required for clerks of court to answer general questions from the public.
- 4. The Attorney General's staff will direct and review work of the contracted probate attorney.

### FISCAL IMPACT:

Contracted Attorney, including clerical services, 8 weeks at 6 billable hours/day = 240 billable hours at \$75/ hour = \$18,000 Publishing and distribution costs; 20,000 sets of instructions and forms/year at \$1.90/set = 38,000 Training sessions, 6 locations around the state = <u>1,000</u> <u>FY 82</u> costs \$57,000

Publishing and distribution costs only \_\_\_\_\_FY 83 costs 38,000
