Section 1. Section 20-25-324, MCA, is amended to read:

"20-25-324. Firearms. Security guards who have successfully completed the basic course in law enforcement conducted by the Montana law enforcement academy shall be authorized to MAY carry firearms IN ACCORDANCE WITH POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE BOARD OF REGENTS:

(1) between 5 P.M. and 8 A.M.;

(2) whenever guarding money or other valuables; and

(3) whenever responding to an emergency in which potential harm to an individual exists; sunset and sunrise and at any time when acting as guards for transportation of money or other valuables.

(1) BETWEEN 5 P.M. AND 8 A.M.;

(2) WHENEVER GUARDING MONEY OR OTHER VALUABLES; AND

~~(3) WHENEVER RESPONDING TO AN EMERGENCY IN WHICH POTENTIAL HARM TO AN INDIVIDUAL EXISTS.~~
