A BILL FOR AN ACT ENTITLED: "AN ACT TO PROVIDE THAT A STATE GAME BIRD LICENSE IS REQUIRED TO HUNT UPLAND GAME BIRDS IN MONTANA AND THAT, IN ADDITION TO ANY FEDERAL REQUIREMENTS, ONLY A WILDLIFE CONSERVATION LICENSE IS REQUIRED TO HUNT MIGRATORY GAME BIRDS; AMENDING SECTIONS 87-2-401 AND 87-2-402, MCA."

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:

12 Section 1. Section 87-2-401, MCA, is amended to read:

13 "87-2-401. ~~Class--A--I--resident~~ Resident game bird

14 **Teenage licenses.** ~~III~~ Except as otherwise provided, a

15 resident, as defined by 87-2-102, who is 12 years of age or

16 older may, upon payment of a fee of \$4, receive a Class A-1

17 license which will entitle the holder to pursue, hunt,

18 shoot, and kill upland game birds and possess the carcasses

19 of upland game birds as authorized by department rules.

20 (2) A resident, as defined by 87-2-102, who is 12
21 years of age or older may pursue, hunt, shoot, and kill
22 migratory game birds and possess the carcasses of migratory
23 game birds as authorized by the department rules upon:

24 (a) purchasing a wildlife conservation license; and
25 (b) complying with applicable federal requirements."

10 (2) A person not a resident as defined in 87-2-102a
11 but who is 12 years of age or older may pursue, hunt, shoot,
12 and kill migratory game birds and possess the carcasses of
13 migratory game birds as authorized by department rules upon
14 (a) purchasing a wildlife conservation license; and
15 (b) complying with applicable federal requirements."
