 8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:
 9 Section 1. Appropriation. (1) The following money is
 10 appropriated from the general fund for the biennium ending
 11 June 30, 1983, to the department of administration to fund
 12 the design and construction of national guard armories at
 13 Harlowton and Havre:

14 General Fund

15	Harlowton	\$179,500
16	Havre	164,500

17 (2) The appropriation for construction is contingent
 18 on the department of administration certifying that federal
 19 cost sharing money in the amounts indicated below and
 20 sufficient to complete the project is available and
 21 deposited within the department of administration's state
 22 treasury accounts. When deposited, the money is allocated
 23 to the projects.
