A BILL FOR AN ACT ENTITLEO: "AN ACT TO LIMIT TO A MAXIMUM

OF \$750 THE AGGREGATE TOTAL CONTRIBUTION MADE BY ANY

INDIVIOUAL, ASSOCIATION, CORPORATION, OR OTHER ORGANIZATION

OR GROUP OF INDIVIDUALS TO A POLITICAL ACTION COMMITTEE OR

GROUP ORGANIZED TO SUPPORT OR OPPOSE ANY BALLOT ISSUE AND TO

IMPOSE PENALTIES."

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:

Section 1. Contribution to political action committees limited. (1) Aggregate contributions made by any person to a political action committee or group organized to support or oppose any ballot issue may not exceed \$750. For the purposes of this section, contributions may not be made in any name other than that of the person who in fact supplies such money.

(2) No person associated with a political action committee or group organized to support or oppose a ballot issue, such as a campaign treasurer of such a committee, may knowingly solicit or receive from a person a contribution which in the aggregate exceeds \$750 or which is submitted in the name of another.

Section 2. Penalties. (1) A person who is convicted

for violation of [section 1] is guilty of a misdemeanor and shall be imprisoned in the county jail of the county where the conviction was obtained for a term not to exceed 6 months or may be fined an amount not to exceed \$5,000 or both.

(2) In addition to the penalty provided in subsection (1), each group or political action committee or its campaign treasurer who receives part or all of a person's contribution, which contribution is in violation of subsection (1), shall within 3 calendar days of the judgment pay from campaign funds an amount equaling the total of all contributions received from that person to the secretary of state for deposit in the state general fund.
