BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:

Section 1. Section 7-14-216, MCA, is amended to read:

"7-14-216. Vacancies on transportation board. (1) The selection-board remaining transportation board members shall fill all vacancies occurring on the transportation board.

(2) A member appointed to fill a vacancy shall serve until the first county general election after his appointment."

Section 2. Section 7-14-217, MCA, is amended to read:

"7-14-217. Notice required of opening on board to be filled by appointment. (1) The selection board or the remaining board members shall give public notice of its their solicitation of applications for initial membership on the board or for the filling of a board vacancy."

(2) The notice shall must be published in a newspaper having general circulation in the district, once each week

for at least 2 weeks; and when involving an initial appointment, the last publication to must be at least 2 weeks before the appointment. If there is no newspaper having general circulation within the boundaries of the proposed district, the notice of solicitation shall must be posted in at least three public places within the boundaries of the proposed district for 2 weeks before the appointment."


Dear Representative Marks and Senator Turnage:

In accordance with the power vested in me as Governor by the Constitution and the laws of the State of Montana, I hereby return House Bill No. 507, "AN ACT TO ALLOW THE REMAINING TRANSPORTATION BOARD MEMBERS TO FILL VACANCIES ON THE TRANSPORTATION BOARD; TO REMOVE THE 2 WEEK WAITING PERIOD REQUIREMENT AFTER THE REQUIREMENT OF NOTICE OF VACANCY HAS BEEN MET; AMENDING SECTIONS 7-14-216 AND 7-14-217, MCA," without my signature and recommend the following amendment for the following reason.

After introduction, H.B. 507 was amended to provide for a selection board which would choose persons to fill vacancies on transportation boards, rather than having the remaining board members fill the vacancies. The title was not amended at that time to reflect this change. I am proposing an amendment to the title so it reflects the change in the bill.

I urge your concurrence in this amendment.
