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A BILL FOR AN ACT ENTITLED: "AN ACT TO PROVIDE THAT A SPECIAL ELECTION ON AN ADDITIONAL LEVY FOR A SCHOOL DISTRICT IS REQUIRED ONLY IF NO ADDITIONAL LEVY WAS IMPOSED THE PREVIOUS YEAR, THE ADDITIONAL LEVY IS GREATER THAN THE PREVIOUS LEVY. OR UPON VOTER PETITION; AMENDING SECTION 20-9-353. MCA."

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BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:

Section 1. Section 20-9-353, MCA, is amended to read:

"20-9-353. Additional levy for general fund -election for authorization to impose. (1) The trustees of
any district may propose to adopt a general fund budget in
excess of the general fund budget amount for such district
as established by the schedules in 20-9-316 through 20-9-321
for any of the following purposes:

- (a) building, altering, repairing, or enlarging any school house of the district;
- 21 (b) furnishing additional school facilities for the
 22 district;
 - (c) acquisition of land for the district;
- 24 (d) proper maintenance and operation of the school
 25 programs of the district.

1 (2) However, when the trustees adopt a total general
2 fund budget which exceeds 110% of the general fund budget
3 for the preceding year, they shall file a notice of this
4 increase with the superintendent of public instruction,
5 setting forth the specific reasons for increasing the
6 budget.

7 (3) When Except as provided in subsection (6), when the trustees of any district determine that an additional 9 amount of financing is required for the general fund budget that is in excess of the statutory schedule amount, the 10 11 trustees shall submit the proposition of an additional levy 12 to raise such excess amount of general fund financing to the 13 electors who are qualified under 20-20-301 to vote upon such 14 proposition except that no election shall be required to 15 permit the school trustees to use federal funds received 16 under Title I of Public Law 81-874 to increase the school 17 district's general fund budget as established in 20-9-316 18 through 20-9-321 by the amount of these funds. Such special 19 election shall be called and conducted in the manner prescribed by this title for school elections. The ballot 20 21 for such election shall state the amount of money to be 22 raised by additional property taxation, the approximate 23 number of mills required to raise such money, and the purpose for which such money will be expended, and it shall 24 be in the following format: 25

1	*PROPOSITION

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Shall a levy be made in addition to the levies authorized by law in such number of mills as may be necessary to raise the sum of (state the amount to be raised by additional tax levy), and being approximately (give number) mills, for the purpose of (insert the purpose for which the additional tax levy is made)?

FOR the additional levy•

AGAINST the additional levy.

- (4) If the election on any additional levy for the general fund is approved by a majority vote of those electors voting at such election, the proposition shall carry and the trustees may use any portion or all of the authorized amount in adopting the preliminary general fund budget. The trustees shall certify the additional levy amount authorized by such a special election on the budget form that is submitted to the county superintendent, and the county commissioners shall levy such number of mills on the taxable value of all taxable property within the district, as prescribed in 20-9-141, as are required to raise the amount of such additional levy.
- (5) Authorization—to—levy—an An additional tax <u>levy</u> under the provisions of this section shall be effective for only 1 school fiscal years and—shall—be—authorized—by—a

An act to provide that a special election on an additional levy for a school district is required only if no additional levy was imposed the previous year, the additional levy is greater than the previous levy, or upon voter petition.
