In compliance with a written request received <u>March 5</u>, <u>19</u><u>81</u>, there is hereby submitted a Fiscal Note for <u>HB 522</u> pursuant to Title 5, Chapter 4, Part 2 of the Montana Code Annotated (MCA). Background information used in developing this Fiscal Note is available from the Office of Budget and Program Planning, to members of the Legislature upon request.

Description of Proposed Legislation:

House Bill No. 522 is "An Act Amending Section 61-10-209, MCA, to allow gross vehicle weight fees to be paid for 1-month or 3-month periods; and and raising the fee for registration at such times".

Assumptions:

- 1. It is assumed that 800 logging trucks will license their vehicles for 7 months per year rather than 9 months per year under present law. This G.V.W. fee is \$58.48 per month X 800 vehicles \$47,000 per month X 2 months = \$94,000 (rounded as to \$100,000) less G.V.W. fees to be collected per year.
- 2. Based on the ratio of logging trucks (which are licensed at 75% of full G.V.W. fee) to the number of other vehicles licensed at full fee, the Department of Highways could expect to lose \$175,000 for each month these other vehicles will not be licensed. It is estimated that the average would be $l\frac{1}{2}$ months not licensed by other vehicles. Therefore $l\frac{1}{2} \times $175,000 = $262,500$ (rounded down to \$250,000) loss of revenue per year.
- 3. Therefore total revenue lost is estimated to be \$100,000 + \$250,000 = \$350,000 per year.
- 4. The bill provides for raising the re-registration fee from \$1.00 to \$5.00. This should generate \$40,000 additional revenue per year.
- 5. There is a possibility that some firms will license a vehicle for one month, whereas in the past they would not license until the start of the next quarter. This should generate \$60,000 additional revenue per year.
- 6. The Department of Highways will be required to purchase monthly G.V.W. stickers and these stickers are estimated to cost \$5,000 per year.
