5 EXEMPTION FROM THE SEVERANCE TAX ON OIL AND GAS FOR NATURAL  
6 GAS PRODUCED FROM A WELL 5,000 FEET DEEP OR DEEPER; AMENDING  
7 SECTION 15-36-121, MCA; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE."

9 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:

10       Section 1. Section 15-36-121, MCA, is amended to read:

11       "15-36-121. Exemption from severance tax. (1) It is

12       the public policy of this state to promote a sufficient

13       supply of natural gas to provide for the residents of this

14       state and to lessen Montana's dependence on imported natural

15       gas.

21 (a) placed into a natural gas distribution system for  
22 delivery to consumers after diligent completion of the well;  
23 and

24 (b) distributed by a natural gas distribution system  
25 serving only natural gas consumers a majority of which are

1 within Montana or at least 10,000 natural gas consumers  
2 within Montana.

3 (3) The 3-year exemption provided by this section  
4 shall begin when natural gas from a qualifying well is first  
5 placed into a natural gas distribution system.

FISCAL NOTE

In compliance with a written request received February 3, 1981, there is hereby submitted a Fiscal Note for HOUSE BILL 552 pursuant to Title 5, Chapter 4, Part 2 of the Montana Code Annotated (MCA). Background information used in developing this Fiscal Note is available from the Office of Budget and Program Planning, to members of the Legislature upon request.

DESCRIPTION

An act to provide for a 3-year exemption from the severance tax on oil and gas for natural gas produced from a well 5,000 feet deep or deeper; and providing an effective date.

FISCAL IMPACT

The fiscal impact of the proposed legislation cannot be estimated. The impact of the current exemption on natural gas production through June 30, 1980 has been:

Total Gross Value of Exempt Natural Gas	\$517,158
Tax Rate @ 2.65%	
Revenue Loss	\$ 13,705

LOCAL IMPACT

Counties and cities share the severance tax proceeds from increased annual production. The bill would result in decreased local revenue, but the amount cannot be calculated.
