9 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:

Section 1. Section 15-36-121, MCA, is amended to read: "15-36-121. Exemption from severance tax. (1) It is the public policy of this state to promote a sufficient supply of natural gas to provide for the residents of this state and to lessen Montana's dependence or imported natural gas.

16 (2) Natural gas produced from a well 5,000 feet deep
17 or deeper on which drilling was commenced after December 31,
18 1976, but--before--December-31y-1980y is exempt from all of
19 the severance tax imposed by 15-36-191 for 3 years if the
20 gas produced from the well is:

(a) placed into a natural gas distribution system for
 delivery to consumers after diligent completion of the well;
 and

(b) distributed by a natural gas distribution system
serving only natural gas consumers a majority of which are

within Montana or at least 10,000 natural gas consumers
 within Montana.

3 (3) The 3-year exemption provided by this section 4 shall begin when natural gas from a qualifying well is first 5 placed into a natural gas distribution system.

6 (4) Notwithstanding the provisions of subsection (2),
7 all reporting requirements under the severance tax remain in
8 effect."

9 Section 2. Effective date. This act is effective on10 passage and approval.

In compliance with a written request received **February 3**....., 19, 81., there is hereby submitted a Fiscal Note for <u>HOUSE BILL 552</u> pursuant to Title 5, Chapter 4, Part 2 of the Montana Code Annotated (MCA). Background information used in developing this Fiscal Note is available from the Office of Budget and Program Planning, to members of the Legislature upon request.

#### DESCRIPTION

An act to provide for a 3-year exemption from the severance tax on oil and gas for natural gas produced from a well 5,000 feet deep or deeper; and providing an effective date.

#### FISCAL IMPACT

The fiscal impact of the proposed legislation cannot be estimated. The impact of the current exemption on natural gas production through June 30, 1980 has been:

Total Gross Value of Exempt Natural Gas	\$517,158
Tax Rate @ 2.65%	
Revenue Loss	\$ 13,705

#### LOCAL IMPACT

Counties and cities share the severance tax proceeds from increased annual production. The bill would result in decreased local revenue, but the amount cannot be calculated.
