A BILL FOR AN ACT ENTITLED: "AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS TO
THE RECLAMATION DIVISION OF THE DEPARTMENT OF STATE LANDS
FROM THE RESOURCE INDEMNITY TRUST INTEREST ACCOUNT TO
CONDUCT A STUDY OF THE CONSEQUENCES OF COAL MINING AND
RECLAMATION OPERATIONS ON QUANTITY AND QUALITY OF WATER IN
THE SURROUNDING GROUND-WATER SYSTEMS."

11 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:

Section 1. Appropriation. There is appropriated from the resource indemnity trust interest account to the reclamation division of the department of state lands the sum of \$200,000 for the biennium ending June 30, 1983, for the purpose of conducting the study described in section 2. Section 2. Study of coal impact on hydrologic system.

(1) The reclamation division of the department of state lands shall design a study to meet its needs in determining the probable consequences of coal mining and reclamation operations, both on and off the mine site, to the hydrologic system, in particular, the quantity and quality of water, including the dissolved and suspended solids, in the ground-water systems under seasonal flow conditions. The division shall collect data from the mine site and

surrounding areas sufficient to determine the cumulative impacts of all anticipated mining in the area upon the hydrologic systems of the area, in particular upon water availability. The study and data gathering are intended to supplement or complement the data and material submitted with the application for a permit.

(2) The reclamation division may employ independent consultants to do part or all of the study. However, the reclamation division shall supervise the study, including the scope of work, methodology, reporting procedures, schedules, and progress reports.

Section 3. Permitting to continue. This act is not intended to impose a moratorium on coal mining or to cause a delay in the processing of permit applications.

Section 4. If \_\_ Bill No \_\_ [LC 1008] is passed and approved, any reference in this act to the "reclamation division of the department of state lands" or "reclamation division" must be changed to the "department of natural resources and conservation".

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
