11 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA: 12 Section 1. Section 16-3-305, MCA, is amended to read: 13 "16-3-305. Sale of alcoholic beverages during closed 14 hours unlawful -- lawful business need not be closed. During 15 the hours when the licensed establishments where alcoholic 14 beverages are sold at retail are required by this code to be closed, it shall be unlawful to sell, offer for sale, or 17 18 give away any such alcoholic beverages, and during such 19 hours all persons, save employees of such licensed establishments, shall be excluded therefrom; provided, 20 however, that when a licensed establishment is operated in 21 22 conjunction with a hotel, restaurant, bus depot, railway 23 terminal, or other lawful business other than that of the 24 sale of intoxicating liquor or beer, then such other lawful 25 business need not be closed, but only the part thereof where

- such beer or liquor is sold<u>and that part shall be lockeda</u>
 barricaded<u>a</u> or screened to deny public access to the
