4 A BILL FOR AN ACT ENTITLED: "AN ACT AMENDING SECTION  
5 16-3-305, MCA, TO REQUIRE LOCKING, BARRICADING, OR SCREENING  
6 OF AREAS WHERE BEER OR LIQUOR IS SOLD, DURING HOURS WHEN  
7 SALE OF THOSE BEVERAGES IS PROHIBITED, IN LICENSED  
8 ESTABLISHMENTS THAT REMAIN OPEN FOR OTHER PURPOSES; AND  
9 PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE OF JANUARY 1, 1982."

11 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:

12                   Section 1. Section 16-3-305, MCA, is amended to read:

13                   "16-3-305. Sale of alcoholic beverages during closed

14 hours unlawful -- lawful business need not be closed. During

15 the hours when the licensed establishments where alcoholic

16 beverages are sold at retail are required by this code to be

17 closed, it shall be unlawful to sell, offer for sale, or

18 give away any such alcoholic beverages, and during such

19 hours all persons, save employees of such licensed

20 establishments, shall be excluded therefrom; provided,

21 however, that when a licensed establishment is operated in

22 conjunction with a hotel, restaurant, bus depot, railway

23 terminal, or other lawful business other than that of the

24 sale of intoxicating liquor or beer, then such other lawful

25 business need not be closed, but only the part thereof where

1 such beer or liquor is sold, and that part shall be locked,  
2 barricaded, or screened to deny public access to the  
3 alcoholic beverages during the hours proscribed in  
4 16-3-304."

5           Section 2. Effective date. This act is effective on  
6       January 1, 1982.
