4 A BILL FOR AN ACT ENTITLED: "AN ACT TO PROVIDE FOR A
5 STUDENT BUILDING MAINTENANCE FEE TO PAY FOR REPAIRS
6 NECESSITATED BY VANDALISM AT UNITS OF THE MONTANA UNIVERSITY
7 SYSTEM."

9 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:

10 Section 1. Student building maintenance fee -- amount
11 -- refund. (1) The board of regents of the Montana
12 university system shall cause to be collected a student
13 building maintenance fee in the amount of \$6.50 per student
14 for each academic quarter that he is enrolled in a unit of
15 the university system. The fee shall be deposited in a fund
16 at each respective university system unit, with the proceed-
17 to be used exclusively for costs of repairs to university
18 property necessitated by acts of vandalism.

19 (2) At the end of each academic year the balance
20 remaining in the fund, if any, after deducting the cost of
21 necessary repairs, shall be refunded proportionately to each
22 student enrolled during any quarter of that academic year.

23 (3) Any interest or income earned by the fund,
24 together with any fees or portions of fees not refunded by
25 reason of inability to locate particular students after

1 reasonable effort has been made, may be used to defray costs
2 of the university system unit in administering the fund.
