DESCRIPTION

An act to remove the termination date for application of Class Four property taxation to land and improvements owned by a nonprofit Montana corporation and used for golfing purposes.

FISCAL IMPACT

The proposed legislation removes the termination date of January 1, 1983 to apply for this provision, so there is no fiscal impact during the biennium.
