4 A BILL FOR AN ACT ENTITLED: "AN ACT TO REQUIRE BARBER
5 SCHOOLS TO EMPLOY AS INSTRUCTORS ONLY THOSE PERSONS LICENSED
6 AS INSTRUCTORS BY THE BOARD OF BARBERS; AMENDING SECTION
7 37-30-404, MCA."

9 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:

10 Section 1. Section 37-30-404, MCA, is amended to read:

11 "37-30-404. Barber schools -- operator and instructors
12 -- license fee -- patrons. (1) A barber school or college
13 operating in this state must:

14 (a) have in charge a person who has had 10 years'
15 continuous experience as a barber; and

16 (b) employ as instructors only those persons licensed
17 as instructors under rules adopted by the board. If the
18 owner of the school acts as an instructor, the owner must
19 also be licensed as an instructor under such rules.

20 (2) The owner of the school or college shall first
21 secure a permit to operate granted by the board and issued
22 by the department, on payment of an annual license fee of
23 \$50, and shall keep the permit prominently displayed.

24 (3) The owner shall, before commencing business, file
25 with the secretary of state a bond to this state, which

1 shall be approved by the attorney general, in the sum of
2 \$2,000, conditioned on the faithful compliance of the barber
3 school or college with this chapter and the payment of
4 judgments that may be obtained against the school, college,
5 or owner on account of fraud, misrepresentation, or deceit
6 practiced by them or by their agents.

7 (4) Barber schools or barber colleges may not charge
8 patrons for barbering services and materials rendered.

9 (5) All barber schools or colleges shall keep
10 prominently displayed a substantial sign as a barber school
11 or barber college.

12 (6) On receiving students, all barber schools or
13 colleges shall immediately apply to the department for
14 student permits on blank forms prescribed by the board."
