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4 A BILL FOR AN ACT ENTITLED: "AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE MONEY TO
5 THE DEPARTMENT OF NATURAL RESOURCES AND CONSERVATION FROM
6 THE RENEWABLE RESOURCE DEVELOPMENT CLEARANCE FUND ACCOUNT
7 FOR EMERGENCY ASSISTANCE IN REPLACEMENT OF THE ST. CLAIR
8 CREEK SYPHON IN THE GLEN LAKE IRRIGATION DISTRICT."

10 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:

11 Section 1. Appropriation. An amount of \$650,000
12 \$130,000 is appropriated to the department of natural
13 resources and conservation from the renewable resource
14 development clearance fund account created within the bond
15 proceeds and insurance clearance fund established in
16 17-2-102 to be used for a grant to the Glen Lake irrigation
17 district for the purpose of replacing the St. Clair creek
18 syphon, notwithstanding any provision of law that would
19 otherwise prohibit a renewable resource development grant to
20 an irrigation district. The grant is to be administered
21 under the renewable resource development program and must be
22 made before June 30, 1983, or the money will revert to the
23 renewable resource development clearance fund account. Upon
24 an application for the grant by the Glen Lake irrigation
25 district, the department of natural resources and

1 conservation must within 180 days make the grant provided
2 all conditions have been met. Any funds not so used must be
3 returned to the department of natural resources and
4 conservation for deposit into the renewable resource
5 development clearance fund account.

6 Section 2. Conditions of the grant. Disbursement of
7 funds under this act may be made only after:

8 (1) the project has been authorized by other financial
9 sponsors, if any;

10 (2) initial funding from other sources, if any, has
11 been committed for construction; and

12 (3) an agreement between the department of natural
13 resources and conservation and the applicant has been
14 executed governing the administration and disposal of funds.
