4 A BILL FOR AN ACT ENTITLED: "AN ACT TO PROVIDE FOR AN
5 ALTERNATIVE ENERGY GRANT FOR THE PURPOSE OF CONSTRUCTING A
6 FACILITY TO CONVERT WASTE BIOMASS INTO NONPOLLUTING
7 PELLETIZED FUEL."

9 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:

10 Section 1. Pelletized fuel grant. (1) The department
11 of natural resources and conservation shall make a grant of
12 \$680,250 from the alternative energy research development
13 and demonstration account established under 90-4-103 for the
14 purpose of matching funds available from other sources to
15 construct a facility using waste biomass to produce a
16 nonpolluting, pelletized, alternative form of fuel.

17 (2) The grant shall be made to Fibre, Inc., a Montana
18 corporation, to be used during the biennium ending June 30,
19 1983. Funds expended from the grant may at no time exceed
20 matching funds expended from other sources.
