4	A BILL FOR AN ACT ENTITLED: "AN ACT TO SUBMIT TO THE
5	QUALIFIED ELECTORS OF MONTANA AN AMENDMENT TO ARTICLE IV,
6	SECTION 3, OF THE MONTANA CONSTITUTION TO REQUIRE ELECTIONS,
7	EXCEPT PRIMARY ELECTIONS. TO BE HELD WITHIN 22 DAYS
8	FOLLOWING PAYMENT OR REPORTING OF TAXES.**

10	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:
11	Section 1. Article IV, section 3, of the Constitution
12	of the State of Montana is amended to read:
13	"Section 3. Elections. [11] The legislature shall
14	provide by law the requirements for residence, registration,
15	absentee voting, and administration of elections. It may
16	provide for a system of poll booth registration, and shall
17	insure the purity of elections and guard against abuses of
18	the electoral process.
19	12) An election, except a primary election, of any
20	officer of the state or of any county. city. town. or public
21	school_district_or_an_election_authorizing_bond_issuesmill
22	levies. or an area-wide special improvement district of the
23	state or of any county. city. town. or public school
24	district_shall_be_held_on_a_date_within_22_days_following
25	either the date upon which income tax is payable for

1	calendar year taxpayers or the annual or semiannual date
2	upon which real property taxes are payable."
3	Section 2. Effective date. If approved by the
4	electorate, this amendment is effective July 1, 1983.
5	Section 3. Submission to electors. This amendment
6	shall be submitted to the electors of the state of Montana
7	at the general election to be held in November, 1982, by
8	printing on the ballot the full title of this act and the
9	following:
10	FOR amending the Montana Constitution to require
11	elections, except primary elections, to be held
12	within 22 days following payment or reporting of
13	taxes.
14	AGAINST amending the Montana Constitution to require
15	elections, except primary elections, to be held
16	within 22 days following payment or reporting of
17	taxes.
