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 11    BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:

12            Section 1. Section 67-2-302, MCA, is amended to read:  
 13            "67-2-302. State airports -- operation. (1) The  
 14    department may:

15            (a) lease, for a term not exceeding 10 years, airports  
 16    or other air navigation facilities or real property acquired  
 17    or set apart for airport purposes to private parties, a  
 18    municipal or state government or the national government, or  
 19    a department of either of them, for operation;

20            (b) lease or assign, for a term not exceeding 10  
 21    years, space, area, improvements, or equipment on those  
 22    airports to private parties, a municipal or state government  
 23    or the national government, or a department of either for  
 24    operation or use consistent with the purposes of this title;

25            (c) sell any part of those airports, other air

1    navigation facilities, or real property to a municipal or  
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 4    purposes incidental thereto; and

5            (d) confer the privilege of concessions for supplying  
 6    goods, commodities, things, services, and facilities upon  
 7    the premises of those airports. However, in so doing the  
 8    public may not be deprived of its rightful, equal, and  
 9    uniform use thereof.

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Description of Proposed Legislation

House Bill 630 is an act to authorize DCA to provide security at State airports whenever required by Federal regulations.

House Bill 630 clarifies law enforcement powers of security staff at State-owned airports (currently only West Yellowstone Airports)

Security, as required by the FAA, is provided at the West Yellowstone by DCA and billed to the user Airlines.
