15 (2) in the 9th district, three judges;

16 (3) in the 4th and 13th districts, four judges each;

17 (4) in all other districts, one judge each."

18 NEW SECTION. Section 2. New judge -- how selected.

19 The judgeship created by this act shall be filled initially



BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:

Section 1. Section 3-5-102, MCA, is amended to read:

"3-5-102. Number of judges. In each judicial district there must be the following number of judges of the district court:

(1) in the 1st, 2nd, ~~7th~~, 11th, 16th, and 18th districts, two judges each;

(2) in the 8th district, three judges;

(3) in the 4th and 13th districts, four judges each;

(4) in all other districts, one judge each."

The judgeship created by this act shall be filled initially at the 1982 general election, and the individual elected shall take office on the first Monday of January, 1983.
