HOUSE BILL NO. 688 1 2 TNTRADUCED BY A Hurwitz A BILL FOR AN ACT ENTITLED: "AN ACT TO CREATE THO EXTENSION 4 5 FORESTER POSITIONS; TO ESTABLISH DUTIES; AND TO APPPOPRIATE FUNDS FOR THE EXTENSION FORESTER PROGRAM." 6 7 в BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA: Section 1. State extension forester. There are created 9 10two positions of state extension forester: 11 (1) one to be located in the cooperative extension 12 service at Montana state university; and (2) one to be located in the forestry school at the 13 university of Montana. 14 15 Section 2. Duties. The duties of the extension foresters are to: 16 17 (1) provide information and educational programs for 18 the private forest landowners on marketing, forestry 19 incentive programs, management practices, protections 20 available from insects, disease, and fire, and laws applying 21 to private forest landowners and forestry in general; 22 (2) develop a working relationship with the forest 23 products industry and keep apprised of their needs and technical knowledge: 24 25 (3) participate on intermisciplinary task forces and

teams within the cooperative extension service and the
forestry school and with other agencies concerning the use
and management of forest lands; and

(4) plan and conduct educational programs covering 4 5 forest ecology, forest inventory, and forest economics, stressing the benefits and costs of alternative uses of ń natural resources within private forest lands and the need 7 for natural resources that do not pass through the market. 8 9 as well as the need for reasonable and effective forest land 10 management practices and maximum utilization of the potential in forest products and byproducts. 11

Section 3. Appropriation. There is appropriated
\$215,536 from the general fund to the Montana university
system, cooperative extension Service, state extension
forester program, for the biennium ending June 30, 1983.
