#### SENATE COMMITTEE OF THE WHOLE

Proposed amendment to House Bill 712, third reading copy, as follows:

1. Page 1, lines 14 through 18.

Following: "office"

Strike: the remainder of these lines.
Insert: "this position shall be considered open and subject to nomination and election at the next general municipal election in the same manner as the election of any other person holding the same office, except the term of office shall be limited to the unexpired term of the person who originally created the vacancy. Pending such election and qualification the council shall, by a majority vote of the members, appoint a person within 30 days of the vacancy to hold the office until his successor is elected and qualified"
