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BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:

PAYMENT TO EACH MEDICAL SERVICE PROVIDER.*

Section 1. Uniform disability insurance claim form. The insurance commissioner may prescribe uniform disability insurance claim forms for hospitals and state and local government agencies to be used by all hospitals and by all state and local government agencies in this state. The commissioner shall, to the maximum extent possible, encourage the acceptance of such forms by all insurers transacting disability insurance in this state who require disability insurance claim forms.

Section 2. Separate payment to each provider. All insurers transacting disability insurance in this state, when paying any insured's claim resulting from his obligation to pay for services performed by a hospital, physician, nurse, or other medical provider, must issue a separate check or draft for payment to each medical provider unless the claim is submitted with a disclaimer signed by the medical provider or its agent, showing full payment has

- been received by the medical provider.
- Section 3. Codification instruction. Sections 1 and 2
- 3 are intended to be codified as an integral part of Title 33,
- 4 chapter 22, part 1, and the provisions of Title 33 apply to
- 5 sections 1 and 2.

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
