In compliance with a written request received <u>February 17</u>, 19 <u>81</u>, there is hereby submitted a Fiscal Note for <u>House Bill 740</u> pursuant to Title 5, Chapter 4, Part 2 of the Montana Code Annotated (MCA).

Background information used in developing this Fiscal Note is available from the Office of Budget and Program Planning, to members of the Legislature upon request.

### Description of Proposed Legislation

House Bill 740 authorizes the Department of Livestock to conduct research in all phases of beef production and to promote the use and consumption of beef and beef products. Provides for funding.

### Assumption

1. Cattle numbers will be about 1,900,000 head.

2. Bill will levy 25¢ per head.

### Revenue Impact

House Bill 740 will generate about \$475,000 annually for research and promotion programs. This money will be deposited in an earmarked revenue account. It is expected that all the money collected under this measure will be spent implementing the program.
