The board 13 of public education shall adopt and prescribe such rules as 14 the board may deem necessary and proper for the maintenance and covernment of the school, the admission of children 15 15 thereto in conformity with the provisions of this chapter, 17 and the qualifications and compensation of the 18 superintendent and teaching staff of the school, provided 19 that said superintendent must have a ready and working 20 knowledge of the sign language and-must-have-taught-3-or 21 more-years-in-a-school-for-the-deaf."
