 10 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:

11 Section 1. Section 20-8-103, MCA, is amended to read:
 12 "20-8-103. Board of public education rules. The board
 13 of public education shall adopt and prescribe such rules as
 14 the board may deem necessary and proper for the maintenance
 15 and government of the school, the admission of children
 16 thereto in conformity with the provisions of this chapter,
 17 and the qualifications and compensation of the
 18 superintendent and teaching staff of the school, provided
 19 that said superintendent must have a ready and working
 20 knowledge of the sign language ~~and-must-have-taught-3-or~~
 21 ~~more-years-in-a-school-for-the-deaf."~~
