BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:

There is appropriated \$4,118,000 from the long-range building program clearance fund account, created within the bond proceeds and insurance clearance fund, to the board of public education for the biennium ending June 30, 1983, for the construction of a physical therapy-physical education facility at the Montana state school for the deaf and blind in Great Falls.
