BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:

Section 1. Appropriation. (1) There is appropriated  
~~\$594,626~~ \$324,626 from the general fund to the department of  
commerce as follows:

Fiscal year 1982	<del>\$297,313</del> <u>\$102,313</u>
Fiscal year 1983	<del>\$297,313</del> <u>\$222,313</u>

(2) The money is to be used by the department to plan  
for and coordinate transportation needs and services for all  
modes of transportation and to pursue rate analysis and  
litigation.
