A BILL FOR AN ACT ENTITLED: "AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE \$188,917
TO MONTANA STATE UNIVERSITY FOR THE PURPOSE OF ESTABLISHING
AND OFFERING A SPECIALIZED FOOD ANIMAL MEDICINE PROGRAM FOR
SENIOR VETERINARY STUDENTS AND PROFESSIONALS."

9 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:

Section 1. Appropriation. The following amounts are appropriated from the general fund to Montana state university for the purpose of establishing and offering a specialized food animal medicine program for senior veterinary students and professionals. The program will concentrate primarily on preventative medicine, herd health planning, and related areas of livestock production as applied to beef cattle cow-calf and range sheep operations:
