4 A BILL FOR AN ACT ENTITLED: "AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE \$188,917
5 TO MONTANA STATE UNIVERSITY FOR THE PURPOSE OF ESTABLISHING
6 AND OFFERING A SPECIALIZED FOOD ANIMAL MEDICINE PROGRAM FOR
7 SENIOR VETERINARY STUDENTS AND PROFESSIONALS."

9 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:

10 Section 1. Appropriation. The following amounts are
11 appropriated from the general fund to Montana State
12 University for the purpose of establishing and offering a
13 specialized food animal medicine program for senior
14 veterinary students and professionals. The program will
15 concentrate primarily on preventative medicine, herd health
16 planning, and related areas of livestock production as
17 applied to beef cattle cow-calf and range sheep operations:
