whereas, a 48-bed nursing home for veterans can be stablished at Galen as an annex of the Montana Veterans.

Home at Columbia Falls for the use of Montana veterans; and

whereas, the establishment of such a veterans' home annex will provide invaluable services to Montana's veterans at a minimal cost to the State of Montana because the annex will generate approximately \$1,030,190 from the federal Veterans Administration and from patient fees resulting in a net outlay from the state general fund of only \$88,467 even though the total capital costs and operating costs for the ensuing biennium will equal approximately \$1,119,600.
