A BILL FOR AN ACT ENTITLED: "AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE \$200,000 TO THE BIOLOGICAL STATION OF THE UNIVERSITY OF MONTANA AT BIGFORK FOR MONITORING WATER QUALITY AND PROVIDING PUBLIC EDUCATION."

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:

Section 1. Appropriation. The following money is appropriated from the general fund to the biological station of the university of Montana at Bigfork for the purpose of monitoring the effects of increased development of natural resources on the water quality of the Flathead River Basin and to provide public education on these effects:

- (1) \$100,000 for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1982;
- and
- (2) \$100,000 for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1983.
