4 A BILL FOR AN ACT ENTITLED: "AN ACT TO PROVIDE FOR A
5 STATEWIDE 3-MILL PROPERTY TAX LEVY TO PROVIDE MONEY FOR THE
6 EXPENSES OF THE CYCLIC PROPERTY REAPPRAISAL PROGRAM
7 ADMINISTERED BY THE DEPARTMENT OF REVENUE; TO APPROPRIATE
8 MONEY FOR THIS PURPOSE; AND PROVIDING AN IMMEDIATE EFFECTIVE
9 DATE."

11 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:

12 Section 1. Statewide levy for property valuation.
13 There is a 3-mill statewide levy against all taxable
14 property in the state of Montana for property tax years 1981
15 and 1982. The county commissioners of each county shall levy
16 the tax. The county treasurer of each county shall remit to
17 the state treasurer, within 30 days of receipt, the tax
18 collected pursuant to this section. The state treasurer
19 shall deposit the money in the earmarked revenue fund to the
20 credit of the reappraisal account.

21 Section 2. Reappraisal account established. There is
22 within the earmarked revenue fund a reappraisal account.
23 Money is payable into this account under section 1. The
24 state treasurer shall draw warrants from this account upon
25 order of the department of revenue.

1 Section 3. Appropriation. There is appropriated
2 \$10,451,864 from the reappraisal account within the
3 earmarked revenue fund to the department of revenue for the
4 biennium ending June 30, 1983. The purpose of this
5 appropriation is for the completion of the reappraisal
6 program mandated under the provisions of 15-7-111 through
7 15-7-114, MCA.

8 Section 4. Effective date. This act is effective on
9 passage and approval.
