10 Section 1. Time limit. The appropriations contained in

12 ordinary expenditures for the year for which the
13 appropriations are made. The unspent balance of any such
14 appropriation shall revert to the fund from which it was
15 appropriated.

16 Section 2. Governor's power to reduce appropriations.
17 The governor may reduce any appropriation in this act by not
18 more than 15%.

19 Section 3. Total not appropriation. The total shown in
20 this act is for informational purposes only and is not an
21 appropriation.

 14 expenditures for the year for which the appropriations are
 15 made. The unspent balance of any such appropriation shall
 16 revert to the fund from which it was appropriated.
