EVENT THE APPROPRIATION UNDER [HB 869] OF \$2,850,000 IS NOT  
EFFECTIVE BY THE END OF THE FEDERAL FISCAL YEAR 1982, THE

In the event the appropriation under [HB 869] of \$2,850,000 is not effective by the end of the federal fiscal year 1982, the sum of \$17,150,000 in the preceding sentence shall be increased by the amount of the appropriation in [HB 869] not used."
