4 A BILL FOR AN ACT ENTITLED: "AN ACT INCREASING THE SIZE OF
5 LEGISLATIVE REPRESENTATION ON THE CAPITOL BUILDING AND
6 PLANNING COMMITTEE; CLARIFYING THE COMMITTEE'S
7 RESPONSIBILITIES WITH REGARD TO RENOVATION AND REMODELING OF
8 THE CAPITOL; AMENDING SECTIONS 5-17-101 AND 5-17-102, MCA;
9 APPROPRIATING FUNDS FOR COMMITTEE ACTIVITIES; AND PROVIDING
10 AN IMMEDIATE EFFECTIVE DATE."

12 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:

13 Section 1. Section 5-17-101, MCA, is amended to read:
14 "5-17-101. Capitol building and planning committee --
15 appointment, composition, and meetings. (1) There is a
16 capitol building and planning committee consisting of eight
17 16 members as follows:

- 18 (a) two six members of the house of representatives
19 appointed by the speaker on a bipartisan basis;
- 20 (b) two six members of the senate appointed by the
21 committee on committees on a bipartisan basis;
- 22 (c) the director of the department of administration;
- 23 (d) the administrator of the architectural and
24 engineering division of the department of administration;
- 25 (e) a representative of the governor's office

1 designated by the governor; and
2 (f) the director of the Lewis and Clark areawide
3 planning organization who shall serve as a nonvoting member.

4 (2) The committee shall select a chairman who may call
5 meetings at his discretion for the conduct of committee
6 business."

7 Section 2. Section 5-17-102, MCA, is amended to read:

8 "5-17-102. Function of committee -- capitol area
9 master plan. (1) The function of the committee is to
10 establish and maintain a master plan for the orderly
11 development of state buildings in the immediate area of the
12 capital city. The master plan shall be developed and
13 maintained with consideration given to the following
14 factors:

- 15 (a) the needs of the state relative to the location
16 and design of buildings to be constructed, purchase of land,
17 parking facilities, traffic management, and landscaping;
- 18 (b) the ordinances, plans, requirements, and proposed
19 improvements of the city of Helena and Lewis and Clark
20 County based without limitation upon zoning regulations,
21 population trends, and plans for rapid transit development;
- 22 (c) any other factors that bear upon the orderly,
23 integrated, and cooperative development of the state, the
24 city of Helena, Lewis and Clark County, and of state
25 property in the immediate area of the capital city.

1 (2) The committee shall consult with and advise the
2 department of administration concerning the assignment of
3 space in the capitol complex and the actual placement of
4 busts, statues, memorials, or art displays of a permanent
5 nature within public areas of the capitol complex. No such
6 item may be permanently displayed unless authorized by the
7 legislature.

8 (3) The committee shall serve as a long-range building
9 committee to recommend to the legislature and the department
10 of administration construction and remodeling priorities for
11 the capitol complex.

12 (4) The committee shall serve as the state's
13 representative in the preparation and implementation of
14 plans for renovation and remodeling of the capitol. In this
15 capacity the committee may decide, based on its study and
16 analysis, the allocation and use of space in the capitol,
17 including without limitation the location of legislative
18 chambers and committee rooms following any remodeling."

19 Section 3. Appropriation. There is appropriated
20 \$15,000 for the biennium ending June 30, 1983, from the
21 capitol land grant account (0412) to the legislative council
22 to fund the activities of the Capitol Building and Planning
23 Committee.

24 Section 4. Effective date. This act is effective on
25 passage and approval.

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BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:

(b) the ordinances, plans, requirements, and proposed improvements of the city of Helena and Lewis and Clark County based without limitation upon zoning regulations, population trends, and plans for rapid transit development;

(c) any other factors that bear upon the orderly, integrated, and cooperative development of the state, the city of Helena, Lewis and Clark County, and of state property in the immediate area of the capital city.
