10 Section 1. Appropriation. There is appropriated from
 11 the general fund to the city-county of Anaconda-Deer Lodge
 12 to mitigate effects upon local government of plant closures
 13 \$160,844 for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1981, and the
 14 biennium ending June 30, 1983, for the following purposes:
 15 (1) \$90,750 for law enforcement;
 16 (2) \$26,821 for the head start program to operate
 17 school services and food programs;
 18 (3) \$17,500 for staff for alcohol and drug service
 19 programs;
 20 (4) \$5,773 for county matching funds for mental health
 21 services;
 22 (5) \$15,000 for aid for moving expenses for displaced
 23 families; and
 24 (6) \$5,000 for costs of administration.
