HOUSE JOINT RESOLUTION NO. 2 1 INTRODUCED BY ___O'CONNELL_ 2 3 A JOINT RESOLUTION OF THE SENATE AND THE HOUSE OF 4 REPRESENTATIVES OF THE STATE OF MONTANA DIRECTING THE FISH 5 AND GAME COMMISSION AND THE DEPARTMENT OF FISH, WILDLIFE, 6 AND PARKS TO ESTABLISH AND PROMULGATE A NEW RULE CLEARLY 7 DEFINING THE PORTIONS OF THE CARCASSES OF GAME ANIMALS+ а 9 BIRDS. AND FISH THAT MUST BE RETAINED AS EDIBLE PORTIONS. 10 WHEREAS. the state of Montana regulates the harvest of 11 game animals, birds, and fish to protect and preserve an 12 exhaustible resource; and 13 WHEREAS, prohibitions against wasting of game animals, 14 birds, and fish in sections 87-1-102 and 87-3-102, MCA, are 15 16 variously interpreted; and 17 WHEREAS, the rules established and promulgated by the Fish and Game Commission and by the Department of Fish; 18 Wildlife, and Parks should define unmistakably the edible 19 20 portions of game animals, birds, and fish that may not be 21 wasted; and WHEREAS, the Legislature desires that the rules defining 22 23 edible portions be expressed in language that will be consistently interpreted, construed, and applied. 24 25

1 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE AND THE HOUSE 2 DE REPRESENTATIVES OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:

3 That within 60 days after passage of this joint resolution, the Fish and Game Commission and the Department 4 of Fish, Wildlife, and Parks are directed to initiate 5 6 proceedings to establish and promulgate, under the authority of sections 87-1-201 and 87-1-301, MCA, rules defining the 7 edible portions of game animals, birds, and fish in language 8 9 that will be clearly understood and consistently 10 interpreted, construed, and applied.
