9 WHEREAS, the State of Montana recognizes the need and importance of providing equal opportunity to all citizens of 10 Montana to participate in the decisions that affect their 11 lives: and 12

WHEREAS, Hispanics constitute a growing minority population in the State of Montana; and

WHEREAS, Hispanics have had little, if representation on various boards, commissions, policymaking bodies whose decisions have a great impact upon the lives of Hispanics in Montana; and

19 WHEREAS, Hispanics will not be able to achieve equality 20 until this lack of representation is corrected.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE AND THE HOUSE 22 OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:

That the Governor is strongly urged 24 to appoint 25 Hispanics to boards, commissions, and advisory or

1 policymaking bodies. Such boards, .commissions, and bodies 2 include but are not limited to those relating to the following areas: education, employment, social services, 3 4 agriculture, arts, business, crime control, housing, human 5 rights, economic development, history, institutions, 6 justice, labor, legal services, mental health, the merit 7 system, petroleum regulation, trade, professional and 8 occupational licensing, higher education, veterans' affairs, 9 and youth justice. 10 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Secretary of State
