1 HOUSE JOINT RESOLUTION NO. 37 2 INTRODUCED BY ______ 3 4 A JOINT RESOLUTION OF THE SENATE AND THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE STATE OF MONTANA REQUESTING THE 5 6 OFFICE OF PUBLIC INSTRUCTION, USING STATE OR FEDERAL FUNDS, TO EMPLOY A PERSON OF HISPANIC DESCENT TO STUDY THE 7 8 EDUCATIONAL PROBLEMS AFFECTING THE CITIZENS OF MONTANA WHO 9 ARE OF HISPANIC DESCENT. 10 11 WHEREAS, it is the goal of the people of the State of Montana to establish a system of education that will develop 12 13 the full educational potential of each person; and 14 WHEREAS, equality of educational opportunity is 15 quaranteed to each person of the state; and 16 WHEREAS, it was stated in <u>Hispanics in Montana</u>, A 17 Report to the 47th Montana Legislative Assembly as Mandated

18 by House Joint Resolution No. 19, "At a more rudimentary 19 educational level Hispanics in Montana are generally about 20 one year behind Anglo students in terms of age and grade." 21

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE AND THE HOUSEOF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:

24 That, the Office of Public Instruction is requested to:25 (1) use state or federal funds to employ a person of

1 Hispanic descent to study the educational problems affecting

2 the citizens of Montana who are of Hispanic descent;

3 (2) develop Hispanic cultural awareness programs for

4 teachers and students; and

5 (3) assist local area school districts in deterring

6 dropping out and truancy by Hispanic youths.
