9	WHEREAS, log scaling is not regulated under Montana
0	law; and
.1	WHEREAS, neither a certification procedure for log
2	scalers nor uniform standards of log-scaling measurement
. 3	exist in the state; and
. 4	WHEREAS: log scaling measurements may vary
.5	considerably; and
6	WHEREAS: a means for promoting confidence among
7	loggers, timber owners, timber contractors, and mill
8	operators would be of benefit to all involved in the logging
9	industry.

21	NOW. THEREFORE. BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE AND THE HOUSE
22	OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:
23	That an appropriate interim committee be assigned to
24	undertake a comprehensive study of log scaling in Montana to
, 5	determine the practicality of establishing a certification

1	procedure for scalers in Montana, acceptable uniform
2	standards of measurement, and regulatory procedures for log
3	scaling.
4	BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the committee is urged to
5	obtain information and encourage participation from mill
6	operators, loggers, scalers, timber contractors, and
7	representatives of wood products associations.
8	BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the committee is urged to
9	study the existence and success of certification procedures.
0	uniform standards of measurement, and regulatory procedures
1	for log scaling in other states and within the United States
2	Forest Service.
3	BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the committee report its
4	findings and recommendations to the 48th Legislature.
