8 OCCUPATIONS LICENSE TAX AND RESTRUCTURING THE CORPORATION

WHEREAS, several legislative sessions have attempted to adjust, refine, and clarify Montana's taxation laws in order to achieve a rational and equitable taxation system to support local government; and

WHEREAS, the mere shifting of tax burdens from one class of taxpayers or property to others does not achieve a defensible or equitable taxation system; and

WHEREAS, the equitable solution to taxation problems involves complex balancing of urban and rural interests; and WHEREAS, the 1979 Legislature attempted to broaden the local tax base by allocating 80% of the corporate license tax on financial institutions to local government.

NOW. THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE AND THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE STATE OF MONTANA: That the Revenue Oversight Committee is requested to study the feasibility of replacing or partially replacing the present property tax system with a business and occupations license tax and restructuring the corporation license tax in order to achieve a more equitable and rational tax system in the State of Montana for the support of local governments. The Committee shall report its findings and recommendations to the regular session of the 48th Legislature.

Description of Proposed Legislation

House Joint Resolution 57 requests a study of the feasibility of replacing the present property tax system with a business and occupations license tax and restructuring the corporation license tax. The Revenue Oversight Committee is requested to conduct the study.

Fiscal Impact

There is no fiscal impact for the following reasons:

- 1. Whether the study would be done is discretionary. The Revenue Oversight Committee would decide.
- 2. Should the Revenue Oversight Committee decide to conduct the study, it would do so within the resources available to it under its appropriation and available staffing.
- 3. Due to the fact that the proposal merely calls for a study of the present tax system, it will have no effect on state or local government revenue during the biennium.
