 6 MONTANA AUTHORIZING THE LEGISLATIVE ADMINISTRATION

 11 WHEREAS, the House sound system was installed more than  
 12 10 years ago and has become inadequate and vulnerable to  
 13 malfunction; and

14 WHEREAS, the printer for the voting system, which  
 15 utilizes obsolete wiring and components, has likewise become  
 16 unreliable and costly to repair; and

17 WHEREAS, the chairs used by members of the House of  
 18 Representatives are in need of repair or replacement; and

19 WHEREAS, the bill retrieval system used by the House  
 20 Sergeant-at-Arms is antiquated; and

21 WHEREAS, under Joint Rule 7-1 the Committee on  
 22 Legislative Administration is the proper committee to have  
 23 control of legislative property and the expenditure of funds  
 24 therefor.

1 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF  
 2 REPRESENTATIVES OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:

3 That the Legislative Administration Committee, in  
 4 consultation with the Speaker of the House, is granted  
 5 authority to:

6 (1) purchase or lease a new sound system for the House  
 7 of Representatives;

8 (2) purchase or lease a new or rebuilt printer for the  
 9 House voting system;

10 (3) purchase or lease a new bill retrieval system for  
 11 the House; and

12 (4) contract for the repair and refurbishing of all of  
 13 the chairs used in the House chambers.

14 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Legislative Council  
 15 pay for such equipment and repairs from funds available to  
 16 the House of Representatives as directed by the Legislative  
 17 Administration Committee.

BY REQUEST OF THE LEGISLATIVE ADMINISTRATION COMMITTEE

A RESOLUTION OF THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE STATE OF MONTANA AUTHORIZING THE LEGISLATIVE ADMINISTRATION COMMITTEE, IN CONSULTATION WITH THE SPEAKER OF THE HOUSE, TO PROVIDE FOR CERTAIN NEW EQUIPMENT AND FURNISHINGS FOR THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES.

WHEREAS, the House sound system was installed more than 10 years ago and has become inadequate and vulnerable to malfunction; and

WHEREAS, the printer for the voting system, which utilizes obsolete wiring and components, has likewise become unreliable and costly to repair; and

WHEREAS, the chairs used by members of the House of Representatives are in need of repair or replacement; and

WHEREAS, the bill retrieval system used by the House Sergeant-at-Arms is antiquated; and

WHEREAS, under Joint Rule 7-1 the Committee on Legislative Administration is the proper committee to have control of legislative property and the expenditure of funds therefor.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:

That the Legislative Administration Committee, in consultation with the Speaker of the House, is granted authority to:

(1) purchase or lease a new sound system for the House of Representatives;

(2) purchase or lease a new or rebuilt printer for the House voting system;

(3) purchase or lease a new bill retrieval system for the House; and

(4) contract for the repair and refurbishing of all of the chairs used in the House chambers.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Legislative Council pay for such equipment and repairs from funds available to the House of Representatives as directed by the Legislative Administration Committee.
