4	A RESOLUTION OF THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE STATE OF
5	MONTANA TO AMEND HOUSE RULE H3-1 TO AUTHORIZE THE SPEAKER OF
6	THE HOUSE TO DESIGNATE MOST OF THE STANDING COMMITTEES OF
7	THE HOUSE.

9	WHEREAS, during a legislative session, the workload of
10	the standing committees of the House of Representatives
11	varies considerably among those committees; and
12	WHEREAS, the economic, social, and political issues of
13	the state vary and assume a different emphasis during each
14	legislative session, thus resulting in an inconsistent
15	workload from year to year within the same committee; and
16	WHEREAS, a more proportionate workload among the
17	standing committees could be achieved if greater flexibility
18	existed in the House Rules for the designation of the
19	standing committees.

21	NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF
22	REPRESENTATIVES OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:
23	That House Rule H3-1 be amended to read:
24	"H3-1. [1] The standing committees of the house ere-es
