 5 A BILL FOR AN ACT ENTITLED: "AN ACT TO PROVIDE CERTAIN
 6 EXCEPTIONS FROM THE ALLOCATION OF THE COAL BOARD TO THE
 7 DEPARTMENT OF COMMUNITY AFFAIRS; AMENDING SECTION 2-15-1104,
 8 MCA."

 10 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:

11 Section 1. Section 2-15-1104, MCA, is amended to read:
 12 "2-15-1104. Coal board -- allocation -- composition.

13 (1) There is a coal board composed of seven members.

14 (2) The coal board is allocated to the department of
 15 community affairs for administrative purposes only as
 16 prescribed in 2-15-121, except that the board may hire and
 17 dismiss its own personnel and may determine all matters of
 18 policy concerning its budget. Subsection (2)(d) of 2-15-121
 19 does not apply for purposes of this section.

20 (3) The governor shall appoint a seven-member coal
 21 board, as provided under 2-15-124.

22 (4) (a) The members of the coal board are selected as
 23 follows:

- 24 (i) two from the impact areas; and
- 25 (ii) two with expertise in education.

1 (b) The governor shall further, in making these
 2 appointments, consider people from these fields:
 3 (i) business;
 4 (ii) engineering;
 5 (iii) public administration; and
 6 (iv) planning.
 7 (5) No more than four members may be residents of the
 8 same congressional district."
