#### REVISED FISCAL NOTE:

The following is a revised fiscal note for Senate Bill No. 50. Revisions were necessary in order to incorporate new assumption Number 7, and due to the fact that County Commissioners' salaries were omitted from current law calculations on the original fiscal note.

#### DESCRIPTION OF PROPOSED LEGISLATION:

An act establishing salaries for elected county officials.

#### **ASSUMPTIONS:**

- 1. That county population will remain at the unofficial 1980 census count throughout the biennium.
- 2. That employers' share of payroll costs increases in direct proportion to gross salaries at 16%.
- 3. That the 30% discretionary increase for County Commissioners' salaries will not be utilized.
- 4. That under existing law, FY 81 and FY 82 elected official salaries would have been increased by 7% annually.
- 5. That only the salary of the elected officials listed will be raised if the measure is bassed.
- 6. That the 1979 Consumer Price Index of 11.5 is the most current measurement for the purpose.
- 7. That the three countys with self-government powers (Silver Bow, Anaconda/Deer Lodge, Madison) will be exempt from the provisions of the bill.
