(2) Initiative petitions must contain the full text of the proposed measure, shall be signed by at least five tempercent of the qualified electors in each of at least one-third of the legislative representative districts and the total number of signers must be at least five tempercent of the total qualified electors of the state. In determining the tempercent figure for the total number of signers on an initiative petition, no more than fifteen percent of the qualified electors from any one district may be included. Petitions shall be filed with the secretary of state at least three months prior to the election at which
